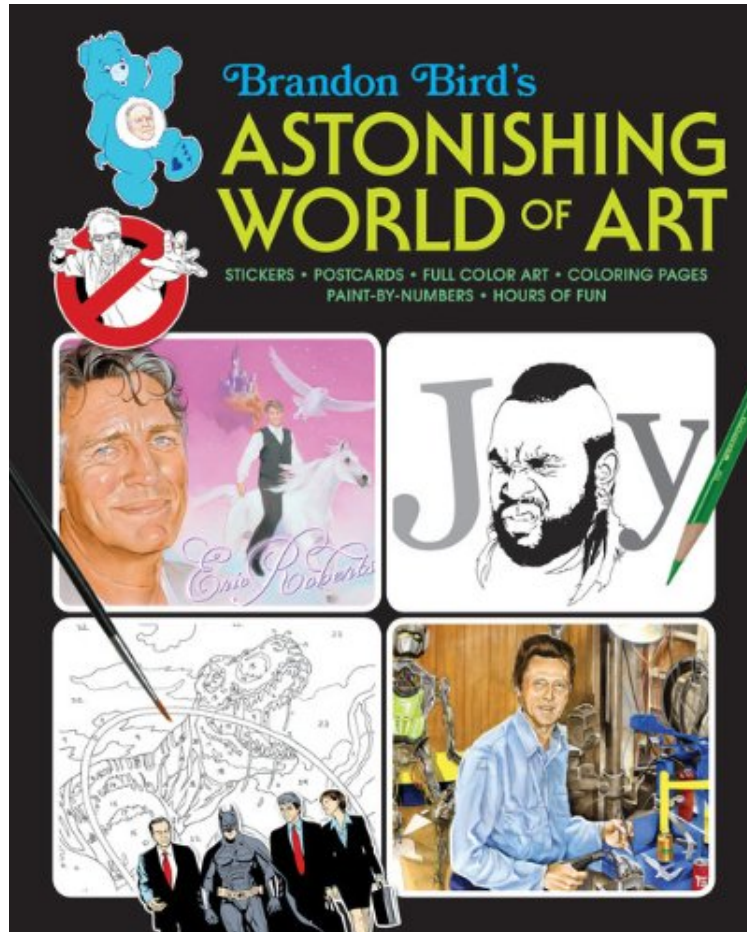

But knowing that some of the guys behind Yo Gabba Gabba! are friends of the author/creator I figured I'd give it a shot.I have to say, when the package arrived and I opened the book for the first time I was blown away by how awesome it is! It's truly an incredible pop culture reference guide. And the way that Brandon Bird so seamlessly combines such juxtaposed iconography is simply masterful. There's not only black and white line drawings, but there's also a section of full color reproductions of paintings, as well as stickers, color by numbers (which are hilarious in their complexity) and finish the drawing type drawings. It's just a really fun book and I'm glad I bought it. My only conundrum is if I should actually color and draw in it and cut it up or keep it mint and pristine. Maybe I should buy a second copy!
