Some people think it is hard to follow, but I don't. You need to spend a little time looking at it and realize that the tables are for the situations listed below the table, not above. I really like the little tabs to find which information I need. There were a couple of times when the information didn't work well for me, but bridge is not an exact game and often has unusual hands.Make sure to write your name on the front of the booklet so if you accidentally leave it behind you'll get it back!!
