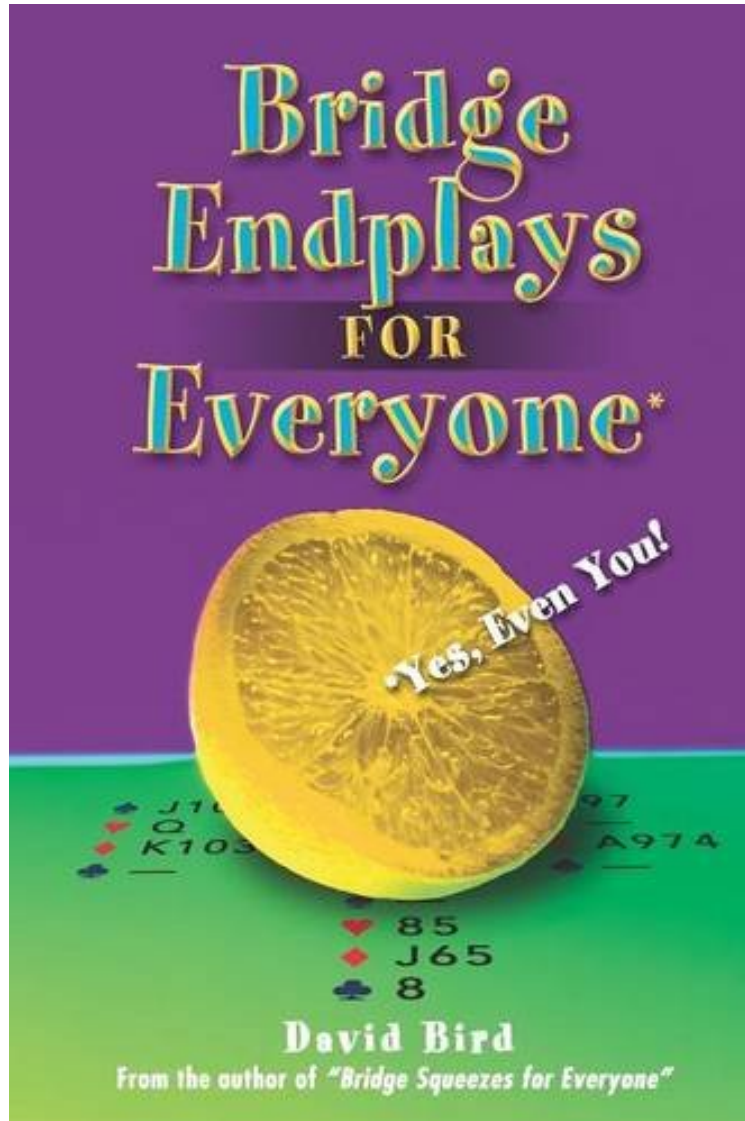

The book includes a number of squeezes (strip squeeze) and emphasizes counting hand shapes. Its not a simple set of problems like lead up to Dummies A Q 9 and endplay RHO.
