Introductory Bridge Book Written for Kids, but Suitable for All AgesBy dclaudewI purchased this print-on-demand book as a possible inexpensive textbook for seniors who are learning bridge. The font is large. The graphics that show possible bids are easy to understand. The first 28 pages cover just the rudiments of dealing, evaluating, playing, and scoring. Pages 29-95 cover bidding. Here a student could

learn appropriate bids and point counts for opener, overcaller, responder, and advancer. Patty tells the student exactly what to bid with minimum, medium, and maximum hands. She devotes a page each for responses to openings of 1C, 1D, 1H, and 1S. For example, on the 1-Heart Opening page, the responder's first bullet under "Without a fit for partner's major" is "6+ points and four or more spades bid 1S." Patty also covers opener's rebids, responder's rebids, No Trump bidding, Jacoby Transfers, Stayman, overcalls, and advancer's bids. A student could bid effectively after learning Patty's 5-card-major system. The book includes twelve practice hands, three pages of definitions, and six pages of Patty's answers to the various quizzes in her book. To me, based on the large font, simple sentences, clear tables, practice hands, and quizzes, both youth and seniors could learn bridge from this excellent 105-page book.<sup>2</sup> of 2 people found the following review helpful.
