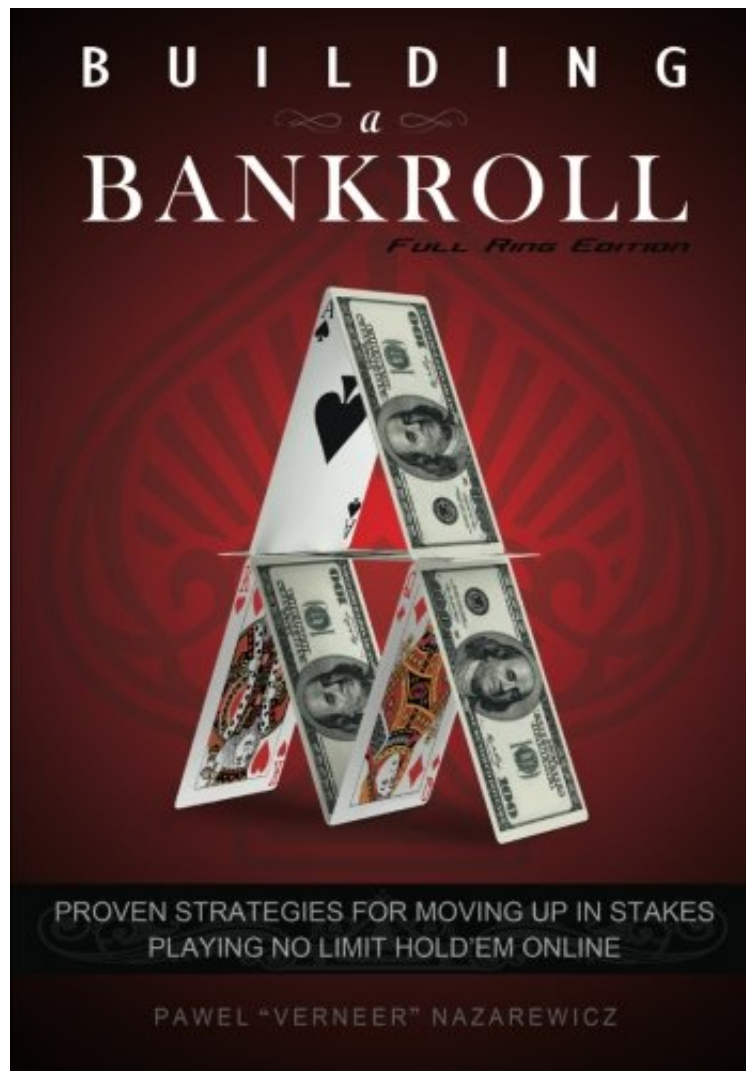

Although initially I was hesitant to purchase "Building a Bankroll" because of its relatively high price, I finally decided to get it based on favorable recommendations. The book did not disappoint and was well worth the price. It clearly explains successful strategies for online microstakes poker (NL 10 to NL 50). This book is not recommended for the absolute beginner, but will be very helpful for players familiar with a reasonable amount of basic poker strategy. The author assumes the reader uses poker software with integrated heads-up display (HUD) and familiarity with poker terms such as "range," "isolation raise," "continuation bet," "value bet," etc. The chapters cover every common situation that occurs in standard online play, including key HUD statistics, hands the player can open (with the important caveat that the player should adjust based on the table and his reads), 3 bets, flop play, continuation bet, and general turn and river play. The true highlight of this book is the many hand examples the author included from his own online games. In each of the hand examples, the author explains the reads on his opponents, the action, and his post-play analysis. Gaining insight into the thinking process of a successful player is invaluable. After reading this book, I am much more cognizant of my mistakes and how my thinking process differs from that of the author's. Although seemingly short, the book has almost no fluff and is filled entirely with practical knowledge. The author's style is straightforward and pithy, almost as if he were the reader's no-nonsense coach. There is almost no abstraction and very little discussion of theoretical concepts or of very unusual hand examples. This is one of the few poker books that I read cover-to-cover. The author cautions this book alone will not miraculously allow the reader to crush the competition at the microstakes. Rather, it will require lots of hard work. The player also needs to avoid tilt and carefully review his hands after his sessions. With this in mind, the author also included chapters on tilt-avoidance and how to perform post-sessions analysis. I highly recommend this book for any advanced beginner seeking practical advice on how to improve his game and be more successful at the online microstakes poker.
