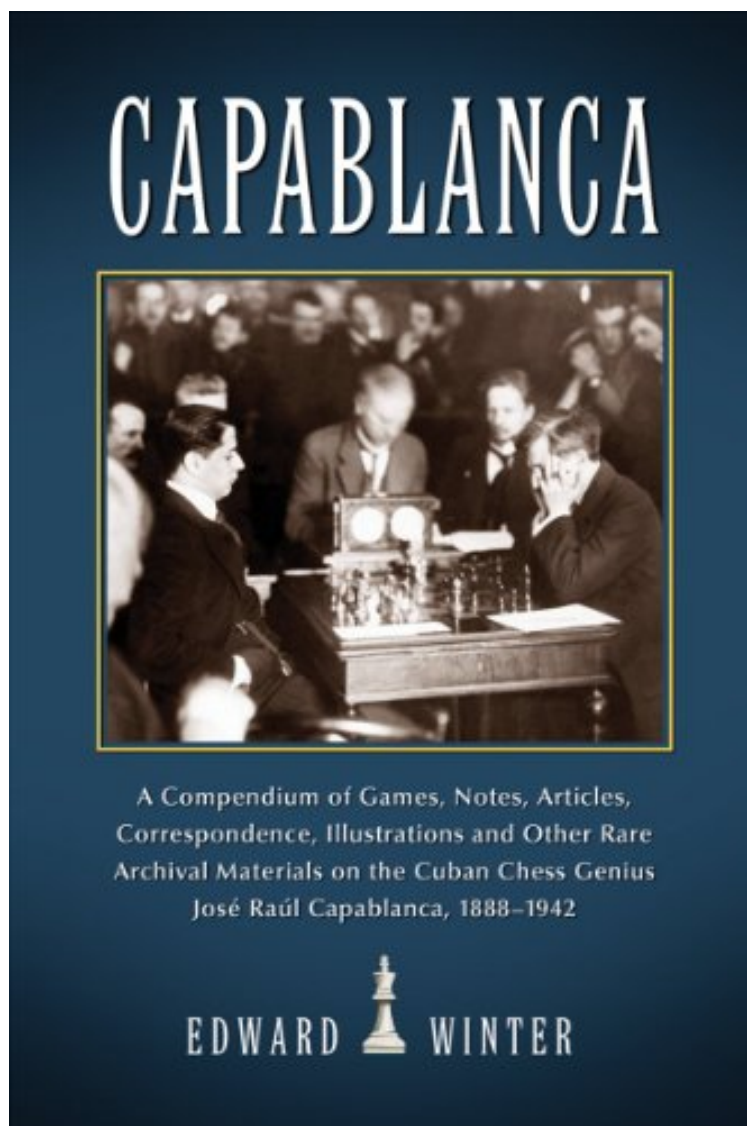

The book has a games and positions index, an index of openings, a general index, and 26 rare photographs on glossy plates.
