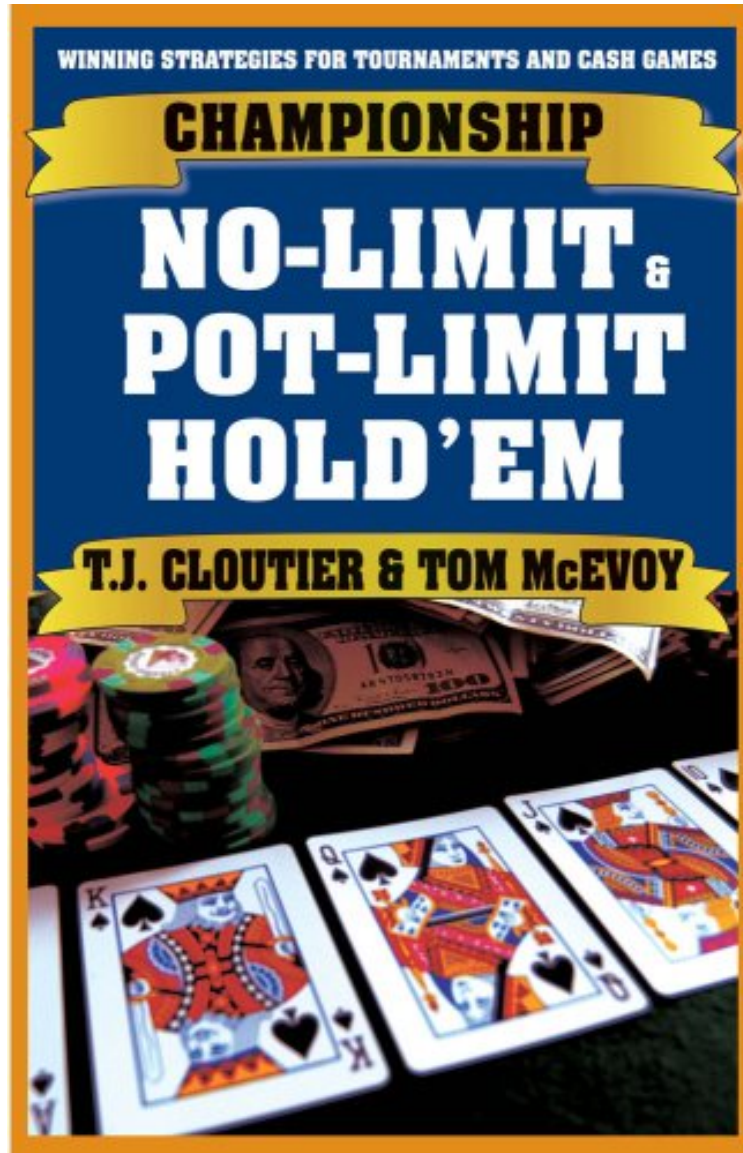

It is written by a couple of old timers (when I say old timers, I do so not as slight, not in the least, just as a statement of fact) who perhaps two of the greatest poker tournament players of all time. Their reasoned insight and experienced wisdom is just what the doctor ordered for players who are struggling to get to the next level in their tournament performance's. Quite bit of the advice and strategy in the book ran counter to how I was approaching tournament play. The authors helped me to understand that what may be the right play in a certain situation isn't necessarily the right play in another one.
