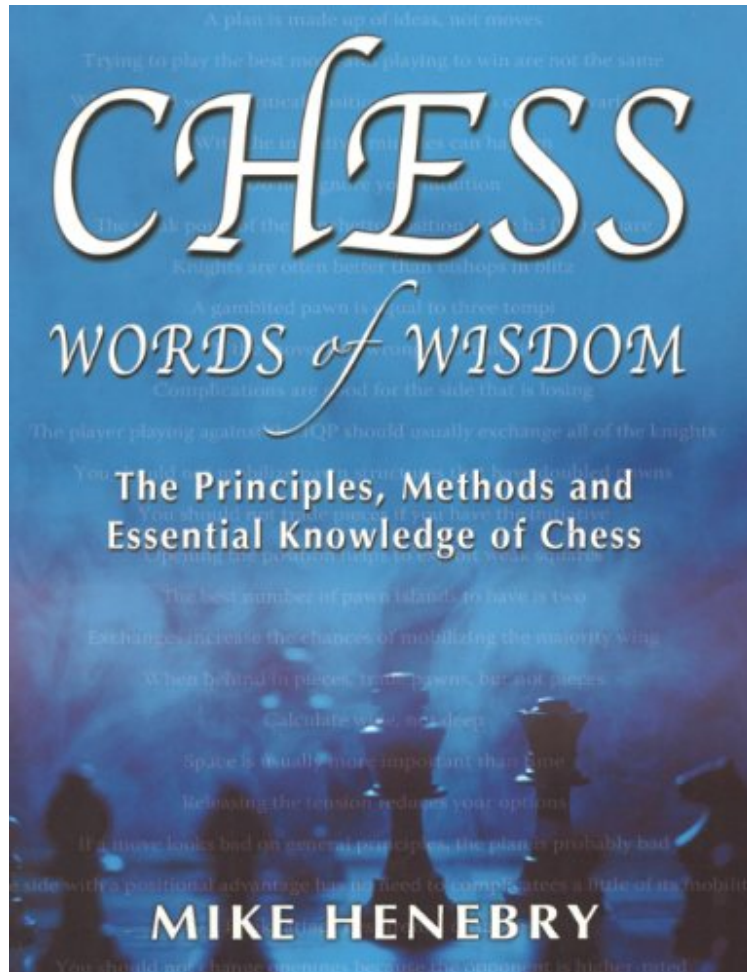

The author has done an excellent job in furthering chess knowledge. I also learned a lot about some of my chess heroes. His claims that you have many books condensed into one is true. He has had to paraphrase some of

his axioms for legal reasons but that's irrelevant. It's their meanings that matter. In preparing for tournaments I have used a similar set of axioms made into an audio recording which I have gleaned from some of my chess books. I would listen to the recording throughout my day. My work was similar to what the author has here but not nearly as extensive. I have found that when I fill my mind with wise sayings they tend to come to mind when needed. I can then decide if they are truly appropriate. In fact I think this should be done for every subject i.e. our jobs, relationships, etc... Because when it comes right down to it, our knowledge in any given subject can be condensed down into these axioms. Our experience on when to use which axiom then turns the axiom into wisdom. I think using this audio axiom study technique helps to organize our subconscious in a way to aid our current efforts.
