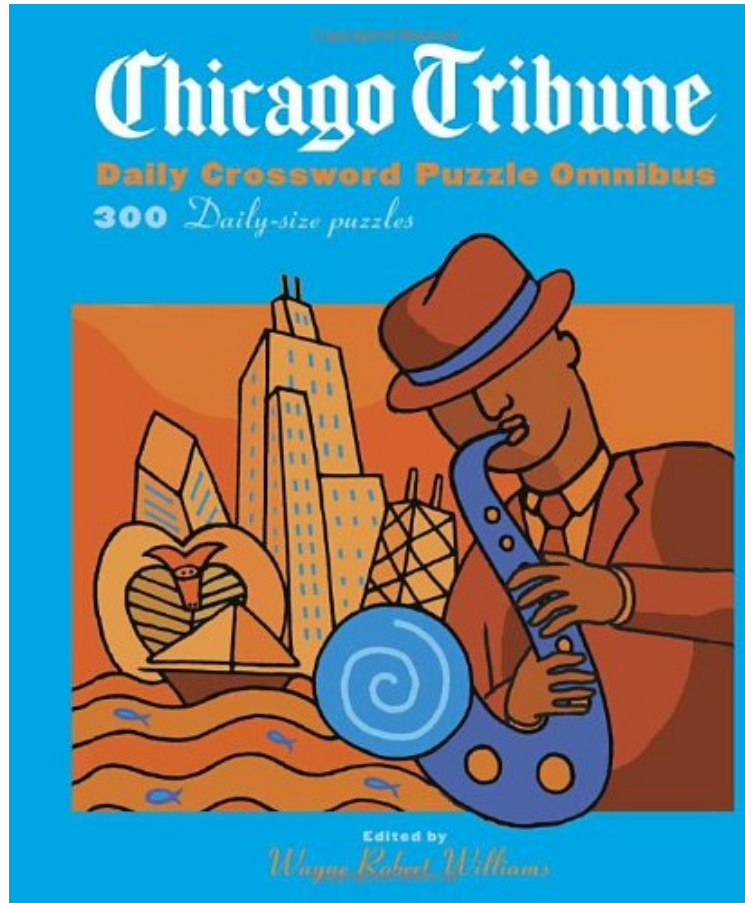

Not as bad as most modern crossword booksBy Patrick LAlthough this book is rated by the publisher as middle of the road as regards its "contemporary" status, many clues are some sort of irrelevant or incoherent pun or wordplay sentences, some ridiculously lengthy. Quite a lot of entries try to replicate not only everyday colloquial language, but urban slang, with some entries not even found in the Urban Dictionary, but they must exist in the creators mind! A large number of the clues hint at some character on a TV show, movie, play, novel, sports team, etc., and their relatives, or even their exes. But it is the plethora of clumsily made-up, meaningless sentences that make this book unpleasant to work with. And the bane of modern day crosswords: arbitrary abbreviations. Just take any word, keep the first three letters and, presto, you create an abbreviation. But at least you have a lot of crosswords to play with and you can just drop those that irk you the most with their irrelevance.1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
