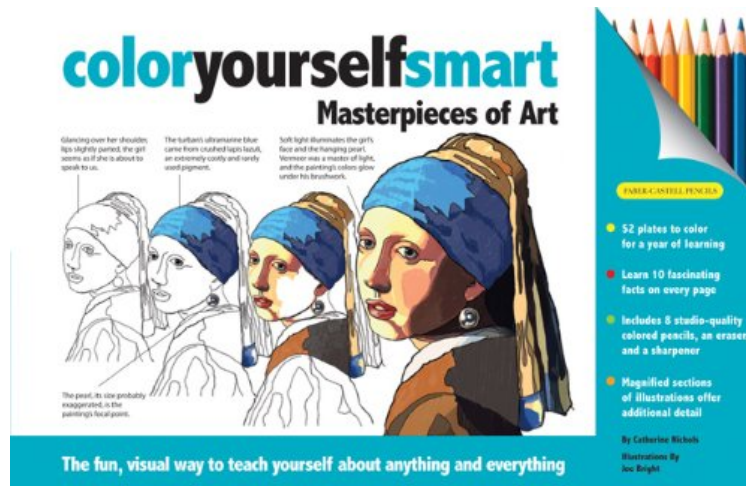

By Casey Payton I ordered this book with the intention of giving it to my 12 year old grand daughter. When it arrived I quickly saw how useless the book would be as a tool to learn about art, or even to doodle in. The information offered on the odd collection of art work only offered a modicum of useful data and very little, if any, new insights. The drawings themselves were busy, essentially useless computer scans requiring the skills of an accomplished commercial artist to complete. If you had that level of skill, you would hardly need this book. The volume itself was nicely bound and printed....giving one the impression of a large "sugar doughnut delivered on a silver tray," entirely devoid of substance and long lasting enrichment. I do not recommend this book for use by children, even if artistically talented. Actually I can't imagine who this book would be appropriate for.
