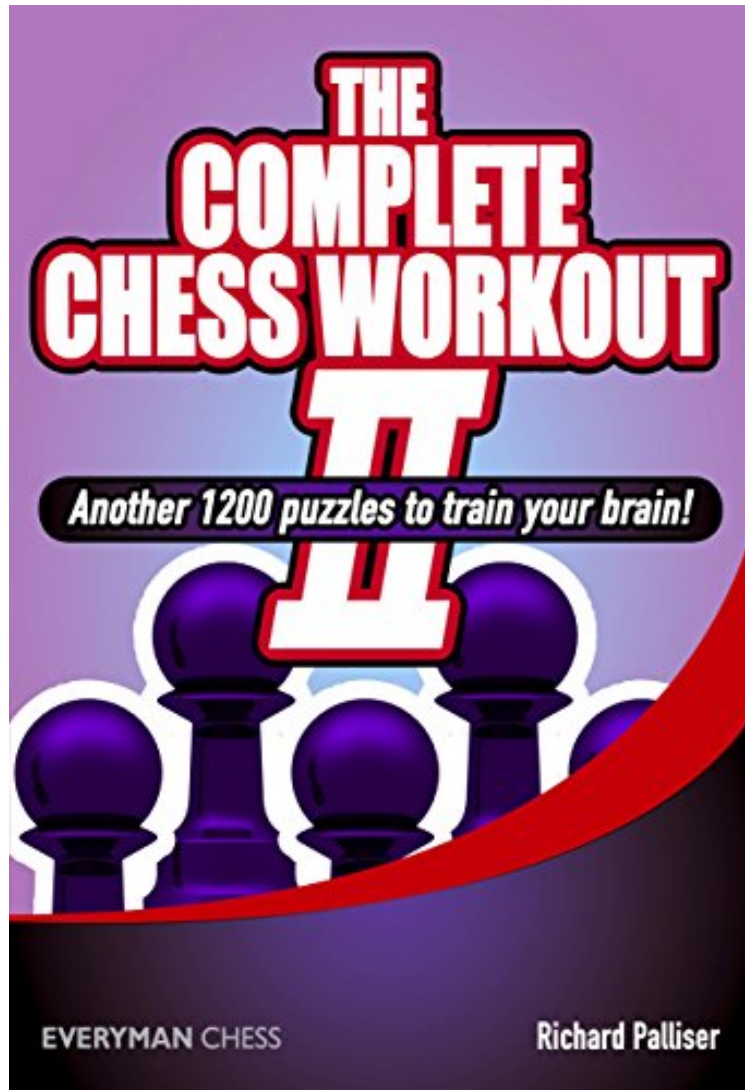

This is a great puzzle book for those looking for intermediate level puzzles. By intermediate I mean puzzles that don't give you a clue, like clue you in on

what to look for Mate in 3, find the pin, find the fork etc... So if you already have an understanding of basic tactical motifs you will like this book. If you are just starting off and dont have a grasp of basic tactics then you may not like this book at this stage. What is really appealing about the puzzles is that you are not always going to get a mate or go up a big piece. Many of the puzzles involve creating a threat and going up a pawn and a few puzzles you need to recognize the position is lost and go for a draw. And in real play you will find one pawn can be the difference between a win and a loss. When I was first working out the problems I was thinking They were using the same puzzles as the previous book, but I did not find a duplicate and realize that its my pattern recognition that has improved. The puzzles are from real games and if you are a clubhouse/coffee shop player your going to see these motifs appear a lot.
