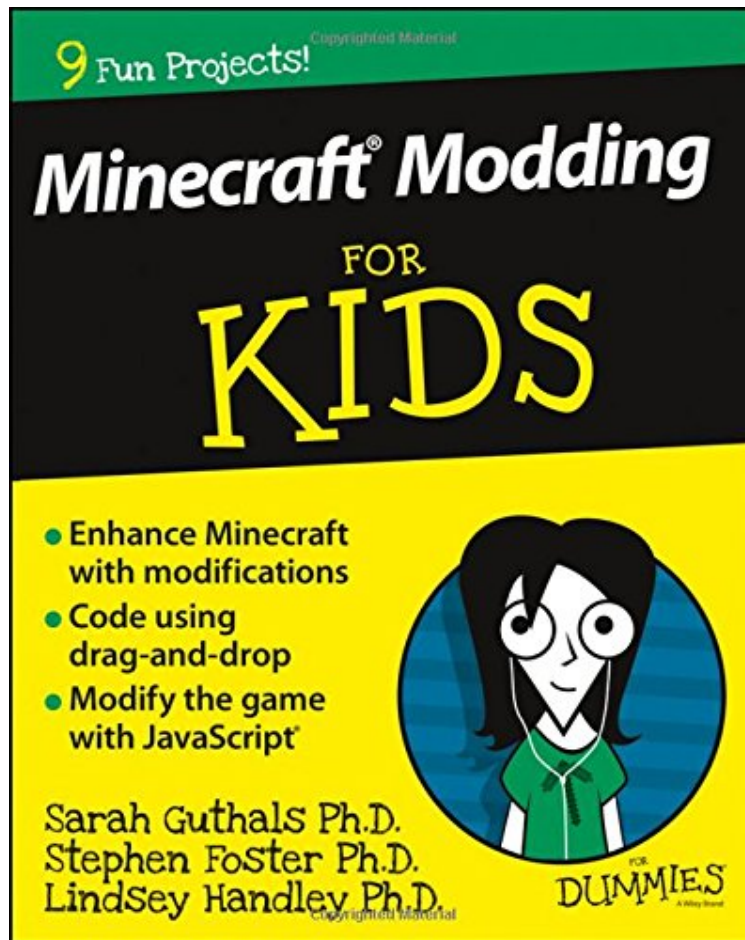

Based on a quick response from their support line, that code is good for one year of access for one person. Additional years or additional people cost \$30/ea for just the code so it's currently a better deal just to buy multiple books for the first year for each person.Lots of questions can be answered here: (removes URLs so see my comment outside the review below.)Essentially to make best use of this book you need individual Minecraft accounts and individual learntomod.com accounts for each person both teacher and student.With that said, the framework they use looks really nice. It's essentially Scratch for Minecraft Mods. This would be especially good for younger
