On a PC, alone or on friend-hosted servers, without the benefit of books like this one.In " Minecraft Seeds: 70 Top Minecraft Seeds Ideas Your Friends Wish They Know", Jason Scotts breaks down the core of Minecraft world building starting with the most logical first step: the seed.For the newbie or non-junkie, let's clear up a common misconception. A "seed" in the sense of Minecraft world creation has nothing to do with plants. For those beyond this very basic knowledge, let's go a step further. Every time a new world is created in Minecraft, a unique code is assigned to the world so that it can continue to be played, altered, saved, and played again. This code, called a seed, is used every time the same world is accessed (and at the risk of being overwhelming, this seed - and thus, this world - can be shared with friends and fellow players by sharing the seed name). So why not take control of your experience?This is where Jason Scotts' book shines. Broken down into sections that read like a personal Tips Journal, the concept of seeds and world building is explained in simple (to the Minecraft player) terms. Seriously, the first section of the book might even be too simple for the experienced player who will find much more retrievable reference material further on. All that said, the book opens with all the

"techy" bits that make seeds a fundamental aspect of Minecraft. But don't let that scare you. A seed is the key to generating a world to love before ever surviving, crafting, or dwelling in it. Building on the knowledge he's shared in the first section, Jason Scotts reveals a nice selection of seeds so specific worlds can be experienced without all the guesswork we used "back in the day". Unlike those days when everything Minecraft was PC-driven, generating seed worlds now varies based on the system the game is being enjoyed on. Jason Scotts tries to leave no one hanging, explaining how seeds are used on each system. As others have pointed out, this is a lightweight book lacking in the graphics department. I'd have loved seeing more than the few examples given of the worlds described without leaving my comfy research spot, waiting for the game to load and having to generate a new world using the seed I'm just curious about in order to visualize it any further than the given description. While the book is intended to be a reference tool - and achieves the goal very well - adding a few images of what turn out to be varied and unique worlds would have enhanced the easy to understand background info and tips. This is far from Jason Scotts' only contribution to Minecraft guides, and I consider myself lucky to have been given the opportunity to receive a copy for review purposes. Each of Scotts' manuals offer an insightful selection of introductory details that make appreciating the "fun stuff" so much more fulfilling. Creative thinking and an exploring mind are vital to enjoying Minecraft. Once through "Minecraft Seeds", players have a new understanding of world building that enlivens the game experience. New to Minecraft or world building? Take a breath and dive right in. Already experienced with seeds? You'll still find some of the seeds offered to be inspiring, but the remainder of the book might be below your interest level.
