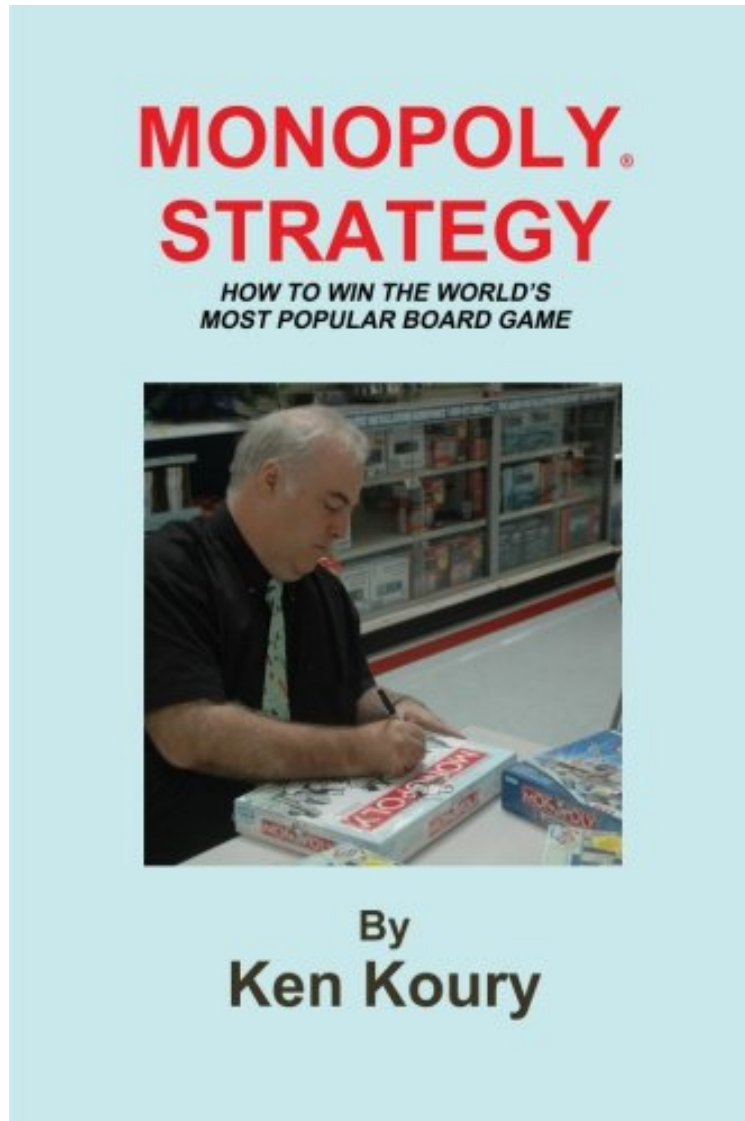

First, it is the only book that is all insider tips. There is no personal investment advice, and he uses the Appendixes for detailed information. One warning, however. Reading a book as good as Ken's does not substitute for actual Monopoly playing experience. I found practicing the secrets harder than I thought, because Monopoly is so dynamic. By Spaghetteman I've read a lot of books on monopoly, and most of them only focus on the probability of each color group and which groups to focus on. Ken Koury's book gives you these details in an easy to understand way, but goes into so much more nuance on both these topics and the more psychological side of the game. This book covers strategies and thought processes you won't find in other books and has definitely helped me step up my Monopoly game by a good deal. Clements This book is dramatically better than many others; that's probably because it does not fall into the trap of being an amateur mathematician's superficial analysis, but focuses rather on how you actually win at monopoly, which has much less to do with knowing which monopoly yields more per player loop and much more to do with weighing alternatives and knowing the players around you. Also, the author's experience yields many amusing anecdotes, and makes the book a lot of fun to read.

Many books have been written about Monopoly, the world's most popular game. Now for the first time a 35-year internationally known Monopoly tournament player shares secret game strategies and tactics previously known and practiced by only a handful of top competitive Monopoly tournament players and coaches.

About the Author Ken Koury is an internationally known Monopoly player, having competed as a player and coach at the national and international tournament levels for more than 35 years. Ken holds two world records in official tournament play for the fastest game (bankrupting 3 players in 15 minutes, 38 seconds) and the highest asset 4-player game in a standard 90 minute round (\$20,882). He enjoys corresponding with fellow players and often plays socially with some of the top players in the country including national and world champions. Players all over the world ask him to settle disputes over the rules and their interpretation, a service he gladly performs for free. On October 18, 2003, he was among the top 48 players in the nation chosen to compete in the United States Monopoly Championship where he took 3rd place. Included in the competition were a number of National Champions as well as the youngest player, Ken's 11 year old daughter Sarina who placed in the top 35 in the United States in classic Monopoly and has remained in those ranks ever since. In terms of classic Monopoly Ken has not dropped out of the top four ranking since 2003.
