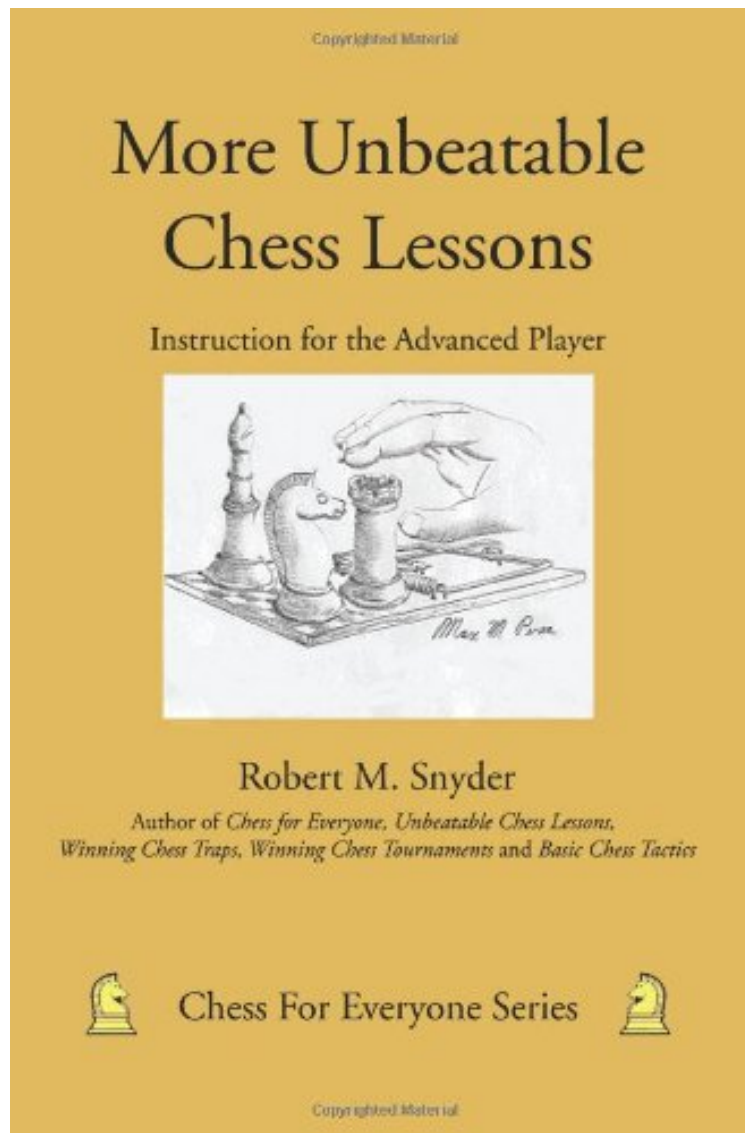

The text accompanying each move is detailed enough to get the general idea, but not too wordy for no reason. The diagrams are spaced appropriately so that I could follow most of the games in my head, but there are a few spots where an extra diagram would have been helpful to me. The author does have spots where he suggests students determine the next best move, but there is no break or warning prior to suggestion, so anyone that reads at any speed will likely have already seen the answer an inch below. All in all a good book.
