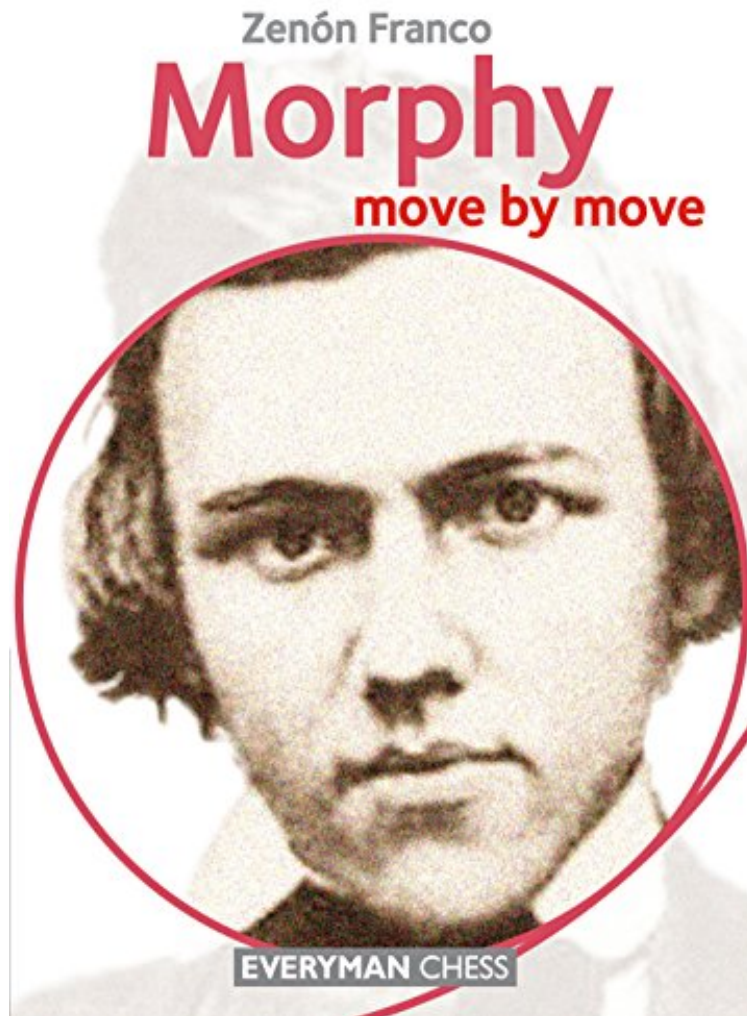

Move by Move. Normally the analysis starts after the opening 5 or 6 moves, and often skips analysis of a few normally obvious moves during the rest of the game. I've played through a number of Paul's games and bought this book with the hope of gaining a greater insight into the reasoning behind the moves. Mr. Franco did not disappoint for the most part he does explain why the moves were good or bad as individual moves. Unlike Mr. Chernev he does look at alternative move to significant depth, but he does so with some commentary on the resulting position and the reasoning behind the move.

Paul Morphy is a chess legend and without doubt one of the greatest players in the history of the game. His understanding of the game was years ahead of his time and in his era he was easily the best player in the world. His chess career was brief but brilliant and he influenced all the great champions who came after him. His legacy includes a treasure trove of wonderful strategic and attacking games which are highly instructive for all aspiring chess players.
