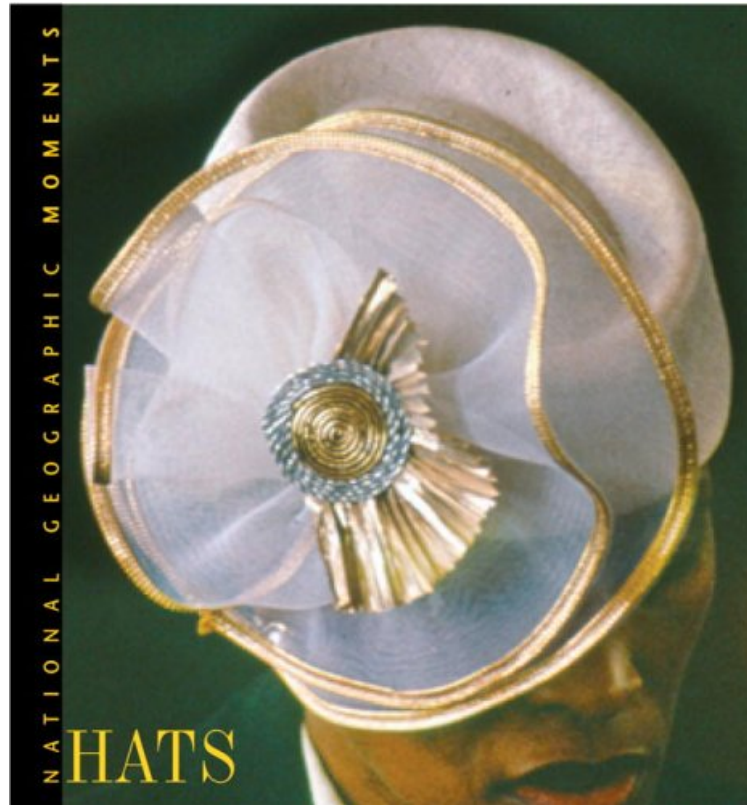

There is no real informative text on anything like the history of millinery fashion or hat-making techniques. Just captions stating place and date.You do, however, get 86 striking photos (both color and black-and-white) that show men and women of many different places and time periods posing with some often very striking head-gear. Some are small photos, and some are a double-spread over both pages.Notable: a photo of exuberant naval graduates throwing their white hats in the air at Annapolis, Maryland; a sea of red berets viewed from above in a parade in Spain; and a little Russian kid in a soldier's outfit complete with a huge fur cap.
