The only complaint I have regarding the book itself is that all the puzzles are in a landscape format, which makes it awkward when doing the puzzles. The side of the book that I'm not working on flops over onto the opposite side, so I have to constantly struggle to keep the book positioned. This is not the fault of the seller. in 1995, yet I can't recall any other NYT Sunday books being in this format; perhaps this was a one-time thing? Yes, the print is tiny, but I actually prefer it that way.
