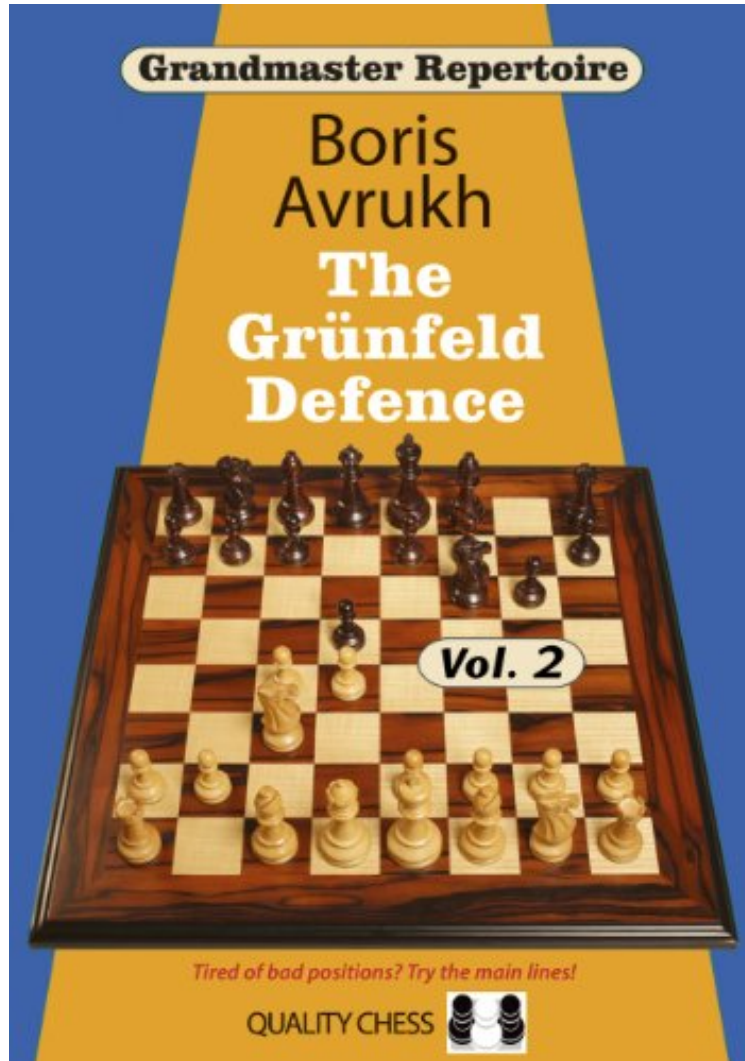

It is aimed at serious players who really want to learn the opening down to its last detail. When combined with a product like ChessBase, you will be able to play this defense against anyone. If you are new to this opening, I would recommend some less challenging books like the Grunfeld Explained or Starting Out the Grunfeld to get an understanding of the basic ideas behind the opening.
