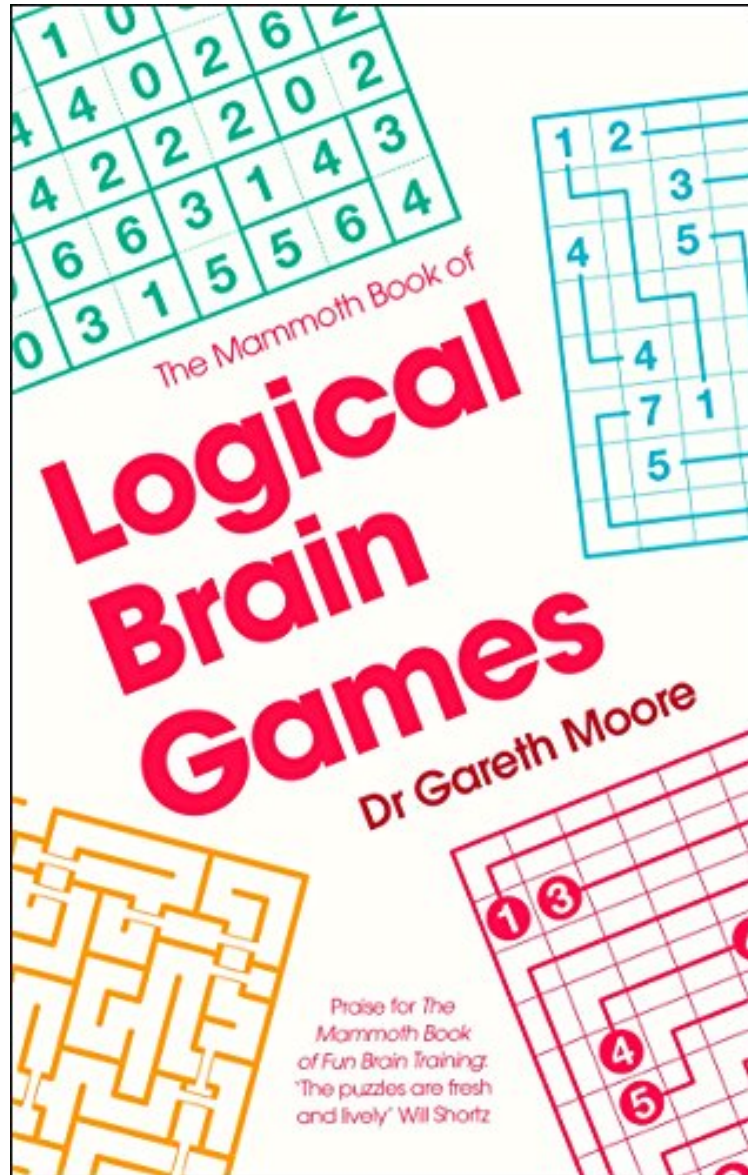

However, these are classic logic games you can find during the World Puzzle Championship. In this book, Gareth Moore picked 63 of these games and built 7 grids with each one, from easy to

very difficult. Don't be afraid of this book, especially if you're fond of Sudoku : take each of the 441 grids as a riddle, a challenge for the brain. The rules are clearly explained and although the first puzzles are not obvious, they're easy enough to preserve the pleasure while solving them. Considering that each puzzle will need an average time of 30 minutes to be solved, this book is a very good investment ! For the moment, I didn't find any mistake in the book, but I will complete this review if I find some in the future.

The Mammoth Book of Logical Puzzle Mazes is filled to the brim with over 450 loop-finding, path-placing, and brain-teasing mazes. It is perfect for improving your memory and sharpening your mind.
