Instead, Saily gives a chapter on each of several modern players (Fischer, Tal, etc.) and tries to explain how he (the player, not Saily) advanced chess ideas. There's usually 2 or 3 games shown per player, which in actuality isn't enough to characterize that player. I think the book could be tighter in showing the connection between one generation's ideas and the next generation's refinements.What's interesting is that Saily is unapologetically in favor of creativity and experimentation.
