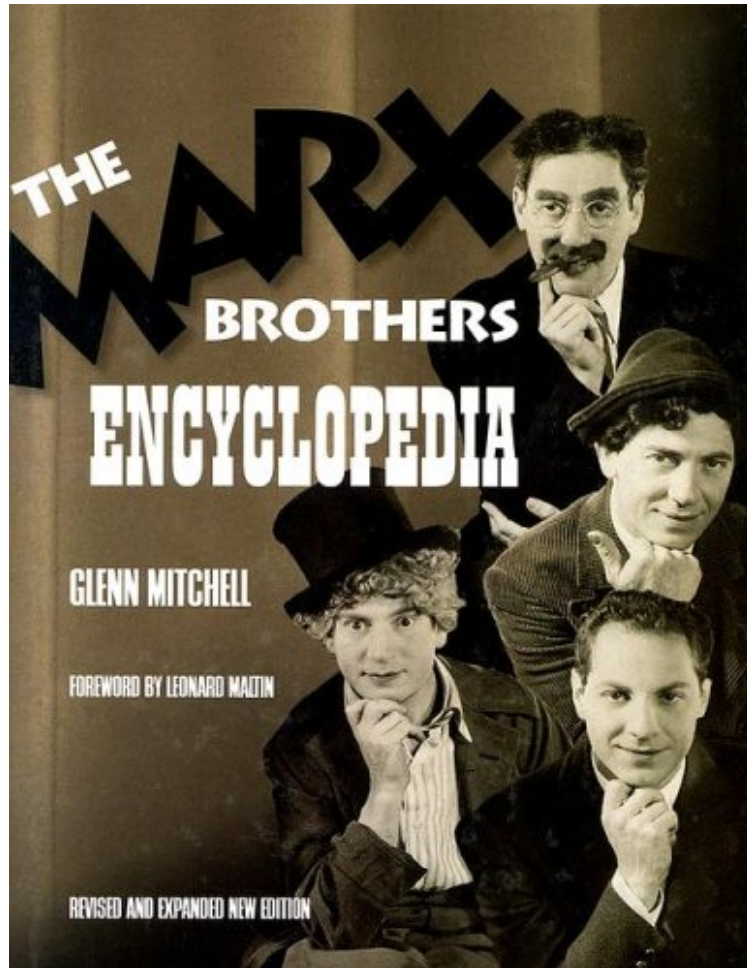

Do not expect this to read with any type of story structure. There is no beginning, middle or end. You will find yourself jumping haphazardly back and forth throughout the entire book.
