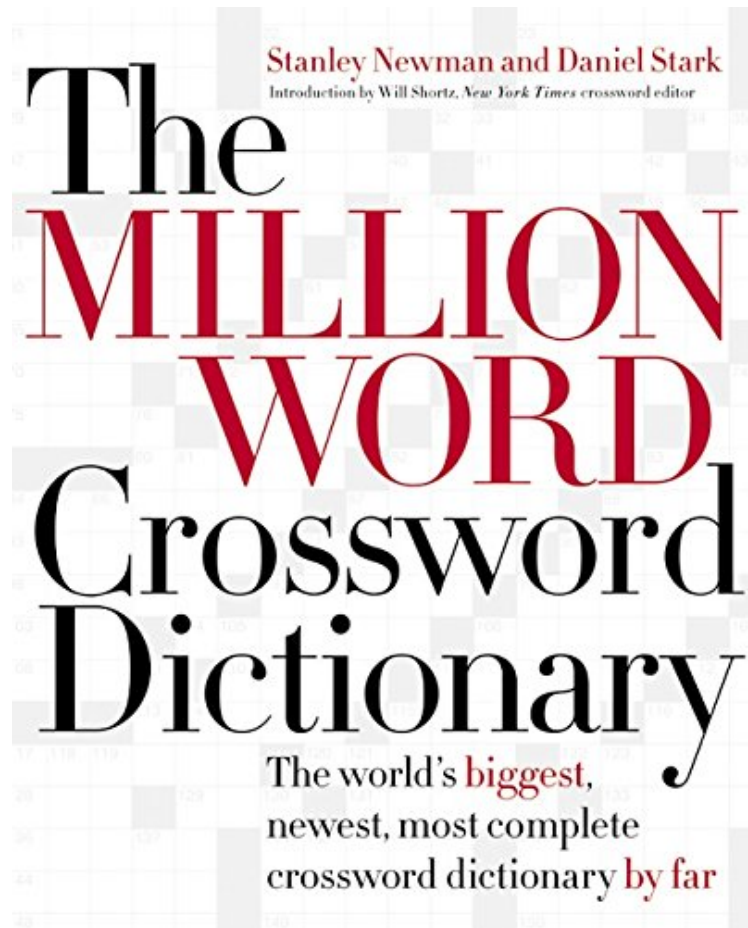

Works well on the Samsung Kindle app By Customer When I first downloaded this book and tried to use it on the Samsung Kindle app I got very frustrated. The app shows a blank white screen with the little arrow going round and round and round. You wait and wait and nothing happens. So I returned the ebook for a refund. However, I wanted to install it on my Kindle Paperwhite so I purchased it again. This time I find that I can use it on the Samsung Kindle app. The trick is to tap the screen when it gets to the white screen situation. Lo and behold, the

dictionary appears. Searching the dictionary is easy and brisk. Use the standard search. But it doesn't work in the standard way. Instead, if your search word is a head word, you are taken immediately to the relevant page. In general, don't put in more than one word. If you do, or if you put in a word that is not a head word, the search drops back to searching the entire document. It is a big document, so not recommended. I haven't managed to download this to my Kindle, but for the moment, I am well pleased with the tablet app performance. Addendum: I found this document on my Paperwhite by accident. It was transferred, but put in with the Dictionaries. I didn't even think to look there. LOL. 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. The best out there. January 2010 update: Having purchased a Kindle, I was excited to get this dictionary on the Kindle, so I wouldn't have to lug out that huge book all the time. I wish that I had read the Editorial Review first, because this book doesn't work on the Kindle - there's no way to search for a word, as a heading. When you search for a word, you get every instance of that word in the whole book. Very disappointed - I wasted the ten dollar Kindle fee on this version. I still love the hardcover; I just wish the Kindle version was better. I would give the Kindle version one star, if I could.
