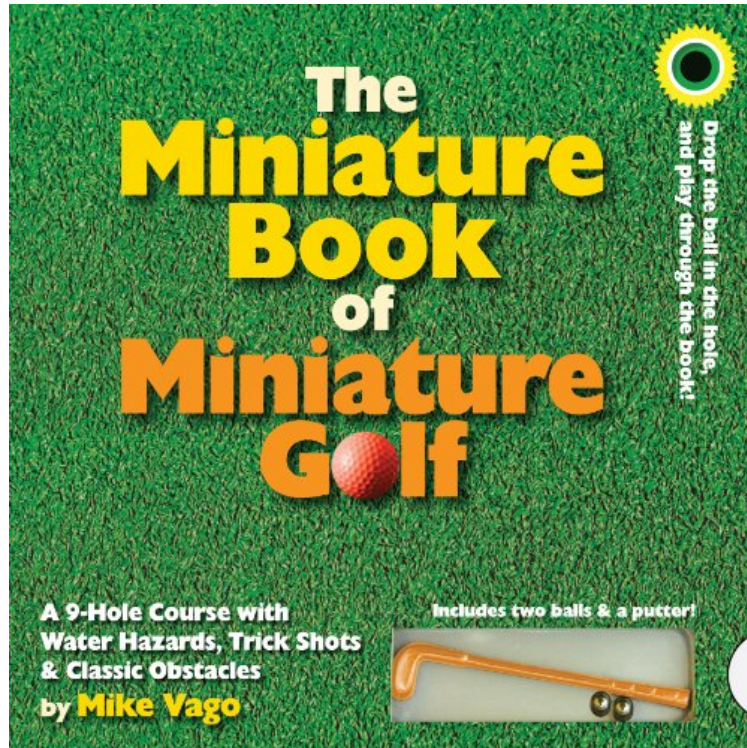

From the Author One common worry with this book is losing the balls, which are pretty tiny. Fear not! They're metal, and very shiny, and show up well against carpet and wood (this has extensively been tested by two preschoolers). If the worst should happen, they're ordinary 3/16" ball bearings, which you can get online or at any bike shop for very cheap.
