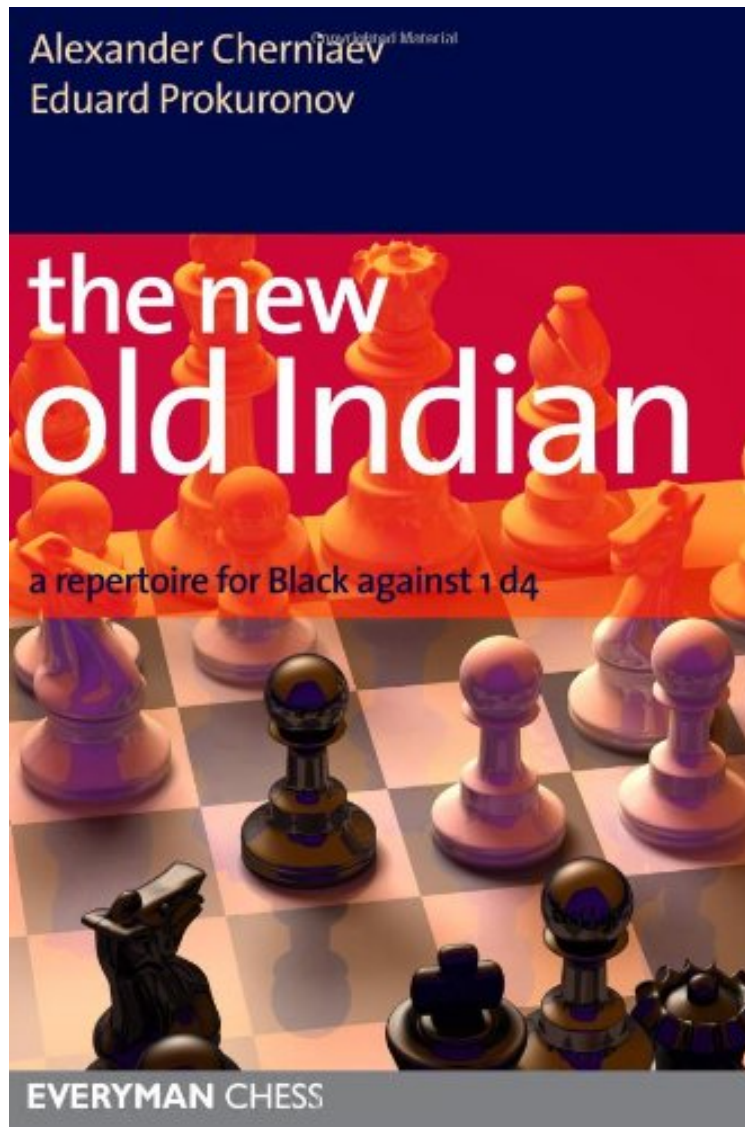

8 of 8 people found the following review helpful. Complicated opening, lotta fun! By CustomerMy rating floats round the 2100 mark... This book is NOT for beginners. Essentially the "Old Indian" is a setup where Black places pawns on d6 and e5 against White's 1.d4 openings. If White plays 1.d4 d6 2.e4 then Black will need to abandon the "Old Indian" idea and head for the Hanham version of the Philidor. However, 1.d4 d6 2.c4 e5 puts the reader in the thick of this

book. If White does not accept the challenge and plays 3.Nf3 then what follows is a very complicated game with chances and interesting positions on both sides. The reason White should opt for 3.Nf3 instead of 3.d4 (dxe5) is that White has a very poor track record in that line (losing more than winning). The reason I gave this book 4 stars is that the material is very dense and needs more explanation. At least it is not a White/Black to play and win type book because the author gives an honest evaluation of every line from both players perspectives. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful. The Old Indian Defence is considered to be a sound way for Black to meet 1 d4. Some might argue that it is steady rather than spectacular, but is this reputation totally deserved? Grandmaster Alexander Cherniaev disagrees, and in this book he has re-examined this ancient opening and the result is a new Old Indian. In this modern interpretation, he has introduced ambitious and aggressive ways for Black to play in the main lines. He constructs an improved version of a repertoire he has himself utilized with great success against grandmaster opposition. Using illustrative games, he studies the fundamental tactical and positional ideas for both sides, and also covers what to do if White avoids the Old Indian.
