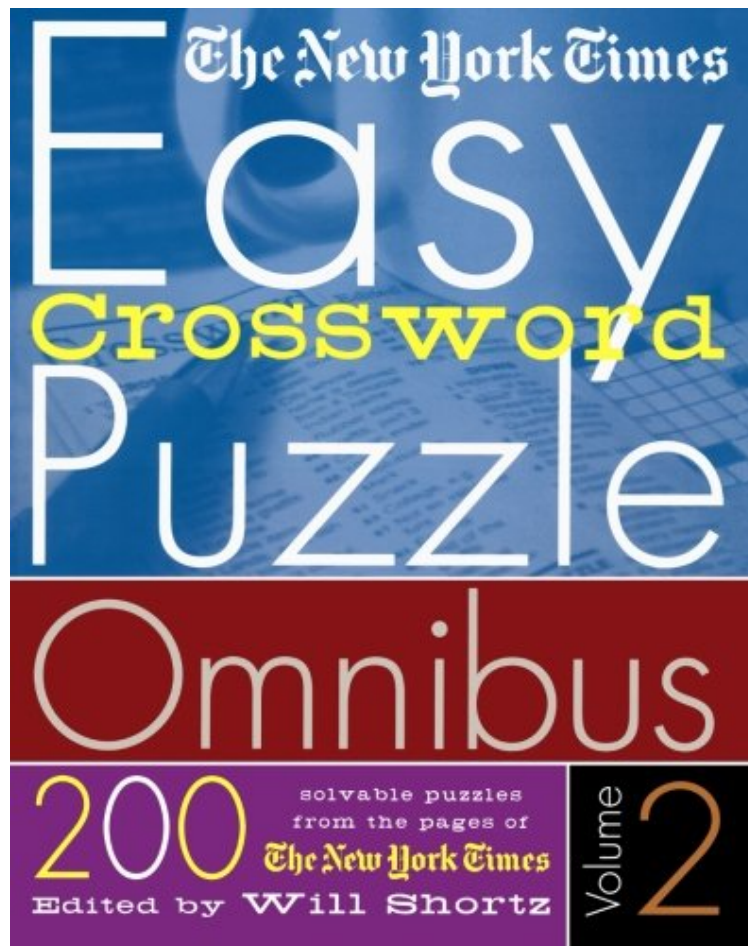

This one is tagged as "easy" but so far only 2 out of 7 have been easy for me - meaning I could finish in about 1 hour. The other 5 still have a few blanks except for the ones where I looked up crosswordtracker.com Pros: they have three theme phrases in each puzzle that makes if fun there are joking or punning clues sometimes that make you laugh

when you finally figure them out. I wanted a challenge - I got one
