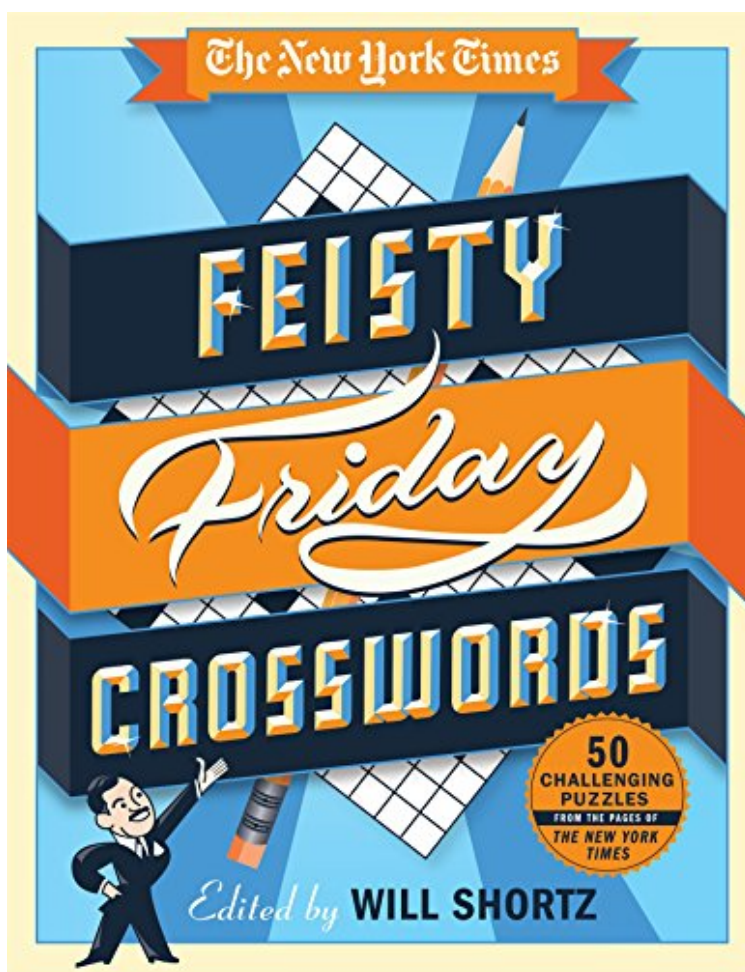

4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. Annoying Error in Puzzle 44By Carl B.Did anyone else notice the mistakes in Crossword Number 44 in this book; both in the puzzle and the answer? Several of the clue numbers were off, 49-Across should have been 50-Across, 52-Across should have been 55-Across. Also, clues 48 through 53-Down should have been one number higher. The grid was screwed up too, the white block labeled 48 should have been

blackened in and the block 4 spaces to the right of that one should have been white. I'm disappointed in the apparent lapse in proofreading here, I've been buying the NYT crossword books for a long time and haven't run into anything like this before. After I saw the error I was able to find online when it was actually published in papers. It was published on May 1, 2015 and it appears to have been correct as published at that time.
