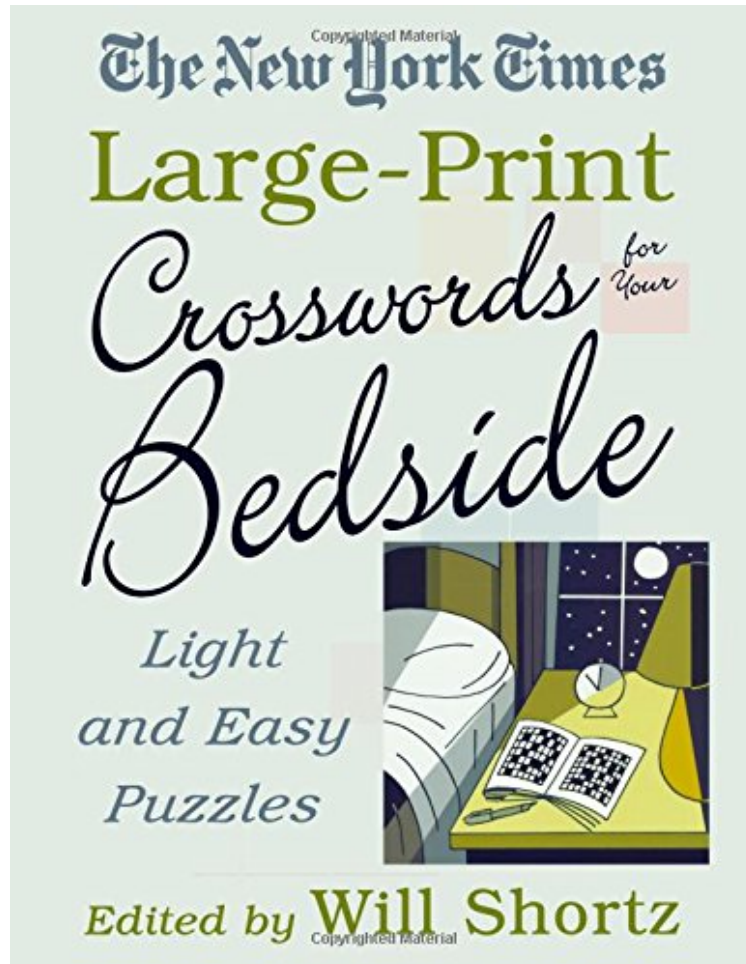

They all carry the Shortz fingerprints even though the grid setters are a diverse group of individual sadists. While certainly in the easy category they include the random pun or anagram to keep everyone on their toes. Additionally, the dating from '99 means the clues can refer to events no longer in the public lexicon, such as the occasional reference to Monica Lewinsky or a Seinfeld episode. They try and edit these out before publishing the grids in book form but a few slip through undetected. An added complication is the odd typo in the
