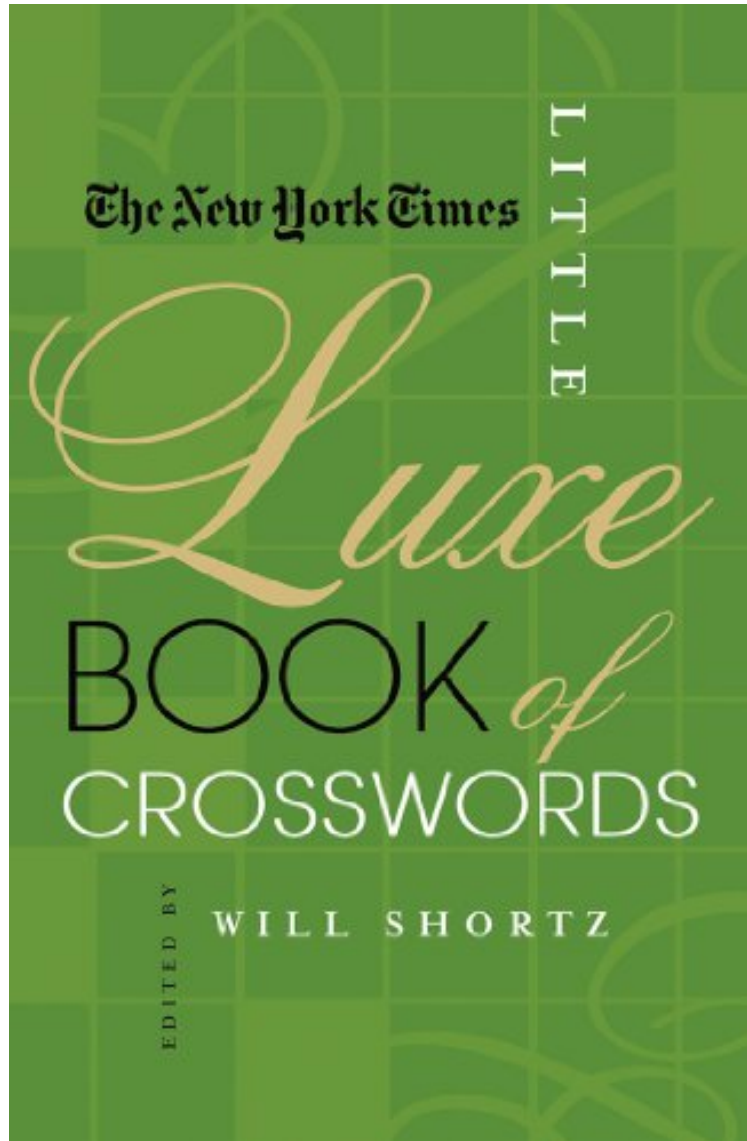

So I was originally going to give three stars due to this. However, as I always do when I am not fully satisfied, I first went back to re-read the

description of the book and it clearly says in the description, that the book "may contain a mark from the publisher" and a "sticker from ". This book also has a sticker on the back from . And, I am assuming the black marking pen is from the publisher. I was able to "remove" most of the black marking pen. This can be done with a paper towel dampened with water and a drop of dish soap. A pencil eraser will also remove some of the marking pen. After re-reading the description of the book and going through the book, I feel it deserves a full 5 star rating, since the "marking" on the book is definitely mentioned. I was impressed when I got this book because of the hard cover. I had neglected to see that in the description also. This definitely makes the book imo. I love the fact that it is hard cover and the reason I ordered it, along with two other puzzle books, was due to the spiral binding. Puzzle books need to be designed this way so that each puzzle can be worked on a nice flat surface which is impossible with regular bound puzzle books where the page on the right side is the only side that is worked on comfortably. The left side of regular bound books, is hard to work due to the big fold; but spiral bound puzzle books are PERFECT. I really love this book and have been having a lot of fun working the puzzles. They are arranged by "stars". One "star" for the easiest, two "stars" for intermediate, and three "stars" for the hardest. In addition, there are 165 puzzles...and this is a real bargain for the very reasonable price of only \$6.95! Also, if you pick at the sticker on the back, you will see that the Manufacturers price is \$14.95 for the USA and \$16.95 for Canada.
