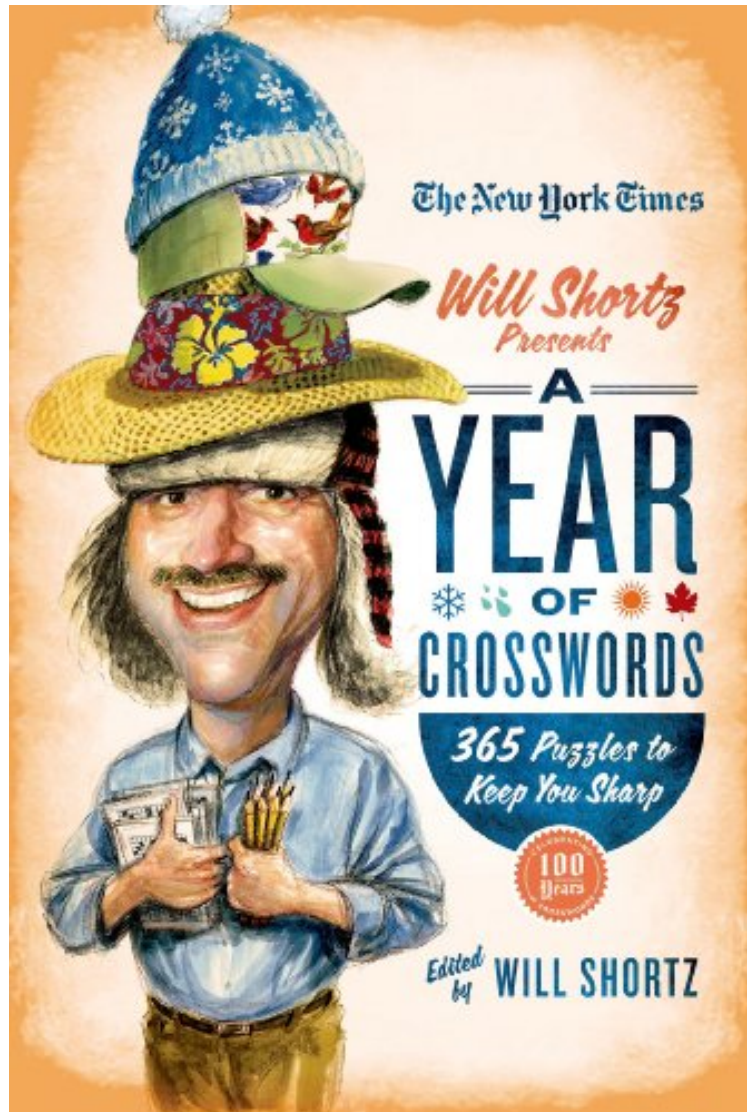

This, of course, reflects the multiple authorships. The puzzles are classified into easy, medium and hard. Therefore, you can choose your crossword depending on your mood and the amount of time you have available to solve it. This crossword book does not suffer from the common problem of recycled puzzles from older books as far as I can tell. The only caution I'd add is that the print is very tiny and you'll need reading glasses if you are older to read the clues.
